When it comes to breast health, RMI STANDS ALONE.

There are a lot of hospitals and imaging centers that offer mammograms. But only RMI offers the most comprehensive breast imaging and support services for women seeking the most advanced care.

There is a common perception that all breast imaging providers are the same. This is not the case. There are differences between the training and experience of the doctors and staff, the type of equipment used and the breadth of services offered.

You have the right to choose your imaging provider. Read on to find out how RMI has built a women's imaging network without equal in Michigan.

Training and Experience Can MAKE THE DIFFERENCE

At RMI, we have doctors who specialize in women's imaging. In fact, many of them have received an additional 1-2 years of advanced fellowship (subspecialty) training in one or more areas of women's imaging. Specialization and advanced training aren't required to read and interpret women's imaging studies. However, we believe this adds a measure of diagnostic confidence for our patients and the physicians who refer them to us.

The RMI Difference: SERVICES

The chances are good that you'll only ever need a screening mammogram. But for women who require additional testing, RMI offers substantial differences.

Here, all of the imaging options are available... and then some. For high-risk women, our 3D UltimateMamm™, breast ultrasound and rapid screening breast MRI provide primary and supplemental screening options designed to achieve the earliest possible detection. For women with suspected breast cancer, our contrast-enhanced mammography, 4D breast MRI and image-guided biopsies provide valuable diagnostic information and/or reduced overall time-to-treatment. For women who want to know their risk, RMI offers genetic testing services to understand their true risk and ensure they qualify for supplemental testing. For all women, our use of artificial intelligence improves screening and diagnostic accuracy.

3D UltimateMamm™ with ProFound AI

Our 3D UltimateMamm (digital breast tomosynthesis) is a significant improvement over traditional 2D mammography. It achieves improved detection of up to 40% with fewer false positives and fewer recalls. It offers improved comfort and shorter exam times. In addition, we are the first center in Michigan to use ProFound AI (artificial intelligence technology), which has further improved detection rates by 8% and decreased unnecessary recalls.

Contrast-Enhanced Mammography

RMI is one of the only centers in the United States to offer this unique capability that combines diagnostic mammography with the use of a contrast agent to detect unusual blood flow within the breast. An alternative to breast MRI, this test can reduce the time-to-treatment by weeks or months for women with breast cancer.

4D Breast MRI

RMI is the first center in Michigan to offer four-dimensional breast MRI, the most advanced technological development in breast imaging. The fourth dimension (time and motion) creates an enhanced view of the real-time function of the breast and any suspected lesions or tumors. It may be used as a follow-up diagnostic exam after a suspicious mammogram, or as a screening tool for high-risk women, women with dense breasts or women who cannot be exposed to radiation due to pregnancy or radiation treatment for another condition.

Breast Ultrasound

Ultrasound uses sound waves to generate images of breast tissue, giving our doctors a detailed view of the breast without radiation or compression. It is most often used to investigate a suspicious lesion found during a mammogram, or to evaluate symptoms such as a lump in the breast or pain. The ultrasound used at RMI can also help differentiate between cysts and solid masses, which can help you avoid an unnecessary biopsy.

Breast Biopsy

For many women, a breast biopsy is used to confirm—or rule out—the presence of cancer in the breast. At RMI, we use all three types of breast biopsy: MRI-guided breast biopsy, ultrasound-guided breast biopsy and stereotactic (x-ray based) guided biopsy. The type of biopsy your physician orders depends on your unique situation, such as the location of a mass, your medical history, or the type of imaging that originally detected the mass.

Genetic Testing

For women at high risk for breast cancer (family history, ethnicity, etc.), RMI offers genetic testing for the BRCA1 or BRCA2 gene mutation. Such a mutation increases a woman's lifetime risk of developing breast cancer from 12% to up to 85%. By having this test, women can start cancer screening at an earlier age, start taking medications to reduce their risk or elect to undergo preventive surgery.
